
The year Windows 10 expects to have broader hypervisor support.

Impact: IT teams leveraging hypervisors other than Microsoft Hyper-V must carefully coordinate their Windows 10 and VDI project plans and timelines.

The number of major migrations after Windows 10, as promised by Microsoft.

Impact: No more (big) migrations – but an ongoing cadence of updates will certainly affect IT's approach to desktop management.

The average amount of time that IT teams will have to test and deploy rolling updates to Windows 10 before risking dependency issues with ongoing security fixes³.

Impact: Faster testing and deployment approaches will be needed to ensure compatibility with security fixes.

The year Microsoft has declared will be End of Life for Windows 7.

Impact: Don't cut it too close, or you may face high support fees or risk security vulnerabilities.
